

Partially Dispensing a Non-Daily CD SDM Instalment on a Later Day



We recommend amending the <u>SDM</u>/ID Script Expiry Days Controlled application setting to reflect the duration of your SDM prescription.

You may encounter a scenario where a patient has been prescribed a controlled drug (<u>CD</u>) on an Addict (MDA) SDM prescription to be collected as non-daily instalments but misses a collection day. For example, the patient is due to collect instalments on Mondays and Thursdays, but fails to collect the Monday instalment and turns up on Tuesday instead. This means the instalment due to be collected on a Monday will be marked as OVERDUE or Dispensed.

In these instances, the pharmacy must still legally supply the remaining instalments and deduct the missed daily dose from the supply. ProScript Connect enables you to partially dispense SDM instalments on a later day, and will automatically deduct the instalment quantity that has been missed.

Use the table below to see when CDR triggers will display, and when entries will be recorded in the CD Register when processing an SDM instalment for a CD




Locating the SDM Instalment

You can mark instalments as dispensed from either the SDM Manager or the <u>PMR</u>. Use one of the methods below to locate the instalment.

Locating the Instalment in the SDM Manager


- 1. From the ProScript Connect Main Screen, access the SDM Manager by pressing [Ctrl+M].
- 2. The SDM Manager opens in a new tab. Adjust the *Filters* as necessary to locate and highlight the overdue instalment you want to partially dispense on a later day, and select the **[Not Dispensed]** button.



Locating the Instalment in the PMR


- 1. To begin, search for and select the patient from the ProScript Connect Search Screen.
- 2. The patient's PMR opens in a new tab. Highlight the item marked as <u>SDM</u> in the first quadrant, and select *Show/Hide Details*. All the instalment details for the SDM schedule display with their respective statuses.
- Highlight the overdue instalment you want to partially dispense, and select ND.





Marking the Item for Partial Dispensing

1. The Mark As Not Dispensed window displays. Select the *Allow Partial Dispensing on a Later Day* tick box. This activates the *Dispense On* drop-down menu, where you can select the day you will be dispensing the instalment on.






2. ProScript Connect updates the *Amount To Dispense* and *Label Split* if necessary. Verify these values and select the **[F10 – Partially Dispense]** button.

Completing the CDR Dispensed Goods Window

You can only save the partially dispensed item as Awaiting Collection. If the patient is collecting the item now, you will need to action this after dispensing from either the SDM or CDR Manager.





Field/Section	Description
Patient Details	The patient details are pre-populated. These details cannot be edited on this screen. If you wish to edit these, you will need to exit this screen and return to the patient's PMR.
Dispensing and Prescriber Details	The drug and prescriber details are pre-populated with the details entered when entering the new script.
Dispenser Details	The signed-in user name and their role are populated by default if configured, but you may have to manually enter the registration number. Otherwise you must fill these details in manually. The <i>Date</i> and <i>Time</i> fields are read-only based on the system date and time of dispensing.
Current CDR Stock Balance	This section provides you with an indication of your current CDR balance prior to collection. It is not directly editable, but you can use the [CDR Balance adjustment] button to adjust the CD Stock Balance for the selected item if required.
Collection Details	This section is disabled during the dispensing of an SDM instalment for a CD item.


If the *Dispensed Drug* in the CDR Dispensed Goods Form is does not match the pack details you are dispensing, you must edit the prescription and amend this once the item has been saved as awaiting collection.

Saving the CDR Dispensed Goods Form

- 1. Once any required changes have been made, select the **[F10 Save as Awaiting Collection]** button. This is not written to the CD Register.
- 2. The system will generate label(s), a bag label (and tracking label if configured).
- 3. You are returned to your starting point, where the following updates have occurred:
 - The instalment is marked as Dispensed in the SDM Manager. ProScript Connect will also indicate the quantity that was partially dispensed against the full quantity.
 - o The instalment is marked as *Prepared* with a breakdown of the *NOT prepared* and *prepared* quantity in the PMR

The dispensed instalment will also display in the CDR Manager on the *Items Awaiting Collection* tab.





The SDM schedule that appears in the SDM Manager will show the partial quantity that has been dispensed against the instalment due date. To see the actual date of the dispensing events, you will need to access the PMR and expand the tree view.

Use the image below to learn about the dates that appear in the PMR for each instalment.
