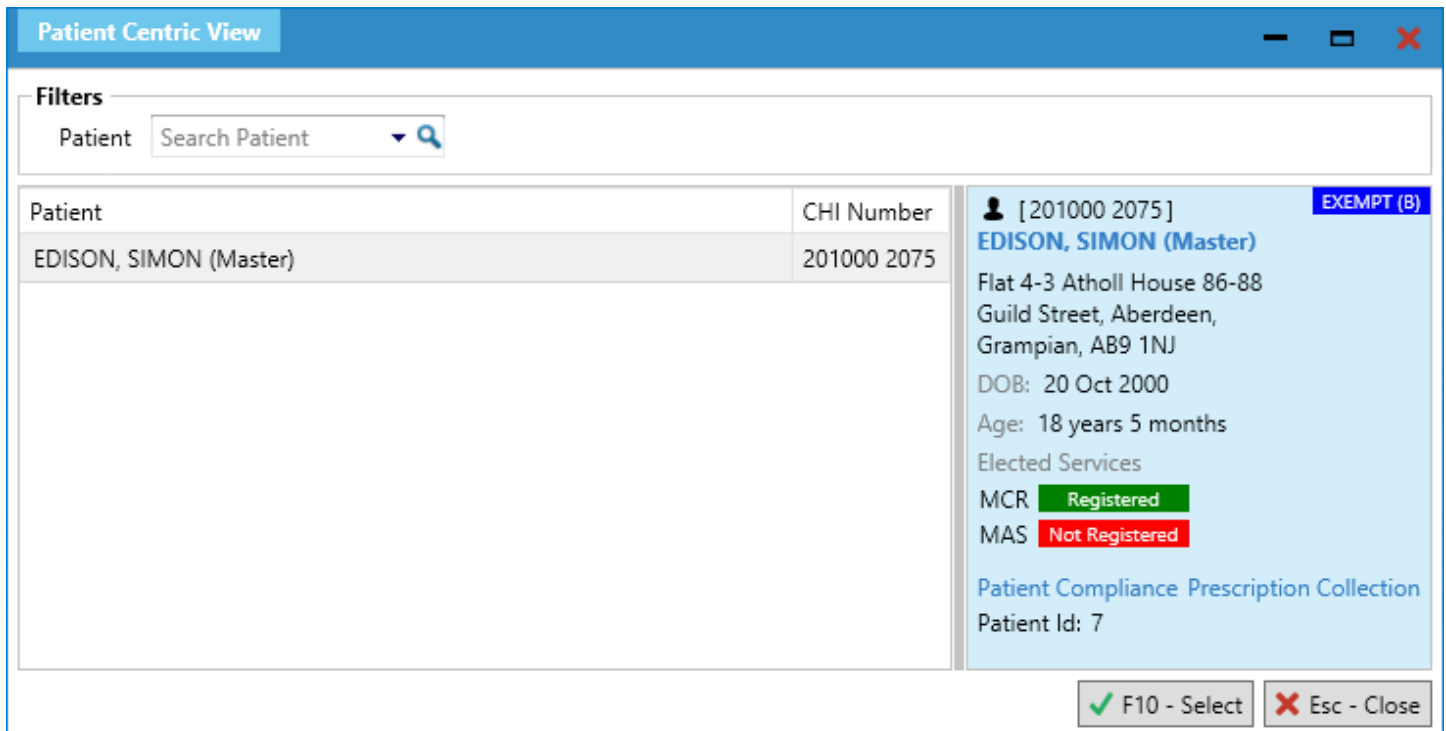


Synchronising MCR Due Dates

In certain cases, patients may have more than one concurrent MCR prescription. To avoid that patient having to come back to the pharmacy twice for two different prescriptions, you can synchronise the due dates for all prescriptions for that patient, so that the patient can come collect their prescriptions on a single due date.

1. From ePharmacy, click the **[Patient Centric View]** button.
