

## Adding a New Counselling Note from the PMR

ProScript Connect enables you to add a new counselling record directly from a selected Patient Medication Record as shown below, or alternatively from the Counselling Notes Manager. A counselling note is an account of clinical advice provided to the patient on the pharmacy premises.

- 1. From the ProScript Connect Main Screen, search for and select the patient.
- 2. The Patient Medication Record displays.
- 3. From the Patient Medication Record, click [Counselling Notes] or [F12 Others] > Counselling Notes.
- 4. The Counselling Notes for the selected patient displays in a pop-up window.

You can set the Counselling Notes window to automatically display when opening the patient's PMR by selecting the *Automatically show Counselling Notes for this patient* tick box within the Counselling Notes window.

- 5. From the Counselling Notes window, press [F1 Add Note].
- 6. A blank Add New Counselling Note pop-up window displays.
- 7. Enter the Description and the Action Taken.

Patient was advised to keep the burnt area clean and covered with a sterile dressing. Dispensed a gauze bandage, and recommended paracetamol or ibuprofen for any pain. Patient has been advised to visit her GP if fever develops, if the wound becomes increasingly painful or begins leaking on the gauze, or if the wound hasn't cleared after 2 weeks.
