Deleting a Counselling Note

- 1. From the Counselling Notes Manager, highlight the counselling note you want to edit.
- 2. Press [F2 Edit Selected Note].
- 3. The Edit Counselling Note displays in a pop-up window.
- 4. Select the **Vote Deleted** tick box. Notice a deleted watermark displays across the window.
