


Top 100 items dispensed report.


The report gives you an indication of your stock usage in the PMR based on the product choice selected for dispensing.

Go to the ProScript Connect menu in the top left-hand corner, then select Stock manager.




Once the Stock Manager opens, select Batch Stock update, then Select Top Movers. Select the date range and enter the number of lines you want to view, e.g. 50, 100 etc. You can then choose either step 5 for the results to be produced in excel or Step 6 for the results to be loaded as a document preview.






If you chose step 5 to run as an Excel file, then you will need to look at columns M and N





If you chose step 6 to run as a document, you would focus on the Packs and units columns under the dispensed section.

In the image below if we look at Apixaban, 14 full boxes of 28pk plus a split pack of 8 tablets was used in the date period selected.



Please note its not uncommon for pharmacies to have negative stock levels. Also, it is common for Specials, ACBS and dressings etc to appear highly as these are usually classed as single items.
