


Printing a PILs & DILs Entry

Amoxicillin for infections

Make sure you tell your doctor if you are allergic to penicillin. Amoxicillin is a type of penicillin - do **not** take it if you are allergic to penicillin.

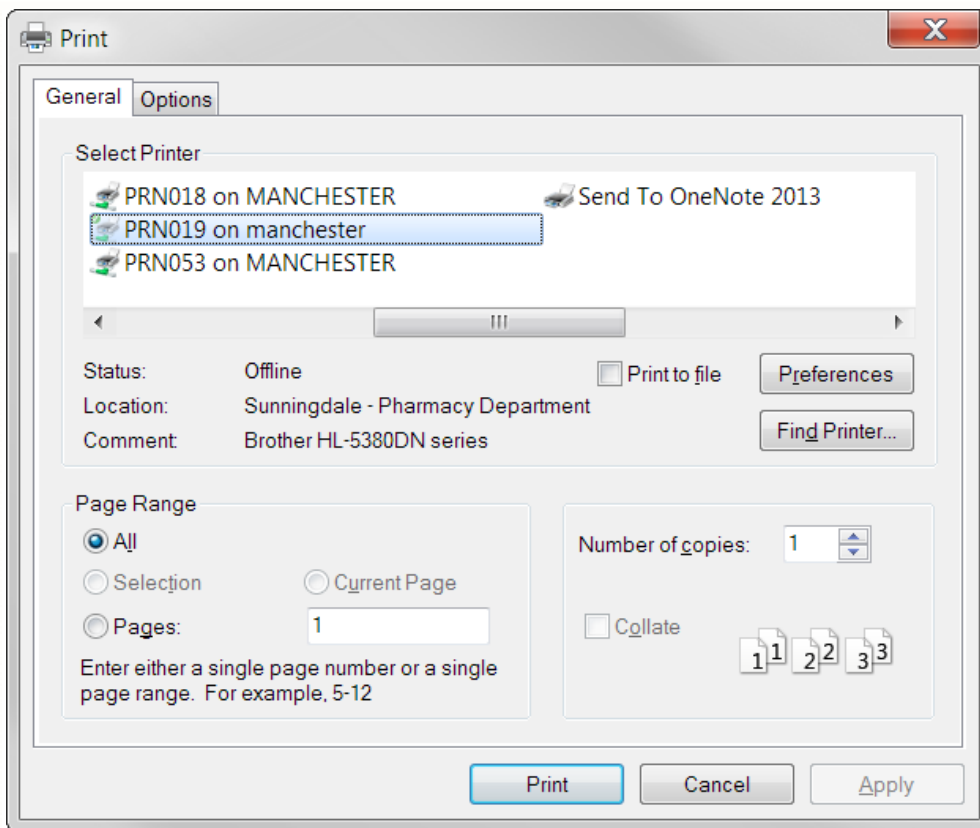
Space your doses out evenly over the day and complete the full course of this antibiotic, even if you feel your infection has cleared up. You can take amoxicillin before or after food.

If you have an allergic reaction (such as any swelling around your mouth, any difficulties breathing or a red rash) contact a doctor straightaway.
