


Viewing the GP Record Viewer

The GP Record Viewer (GPRV) enables you to view a read-only version of the patient's electronic Health Record, including:

- the patient's contact and demographic details
- the patient's medication list
- the patient's allergies and adverse reactions to specific medication
- the patient's monitoring and blood test results
