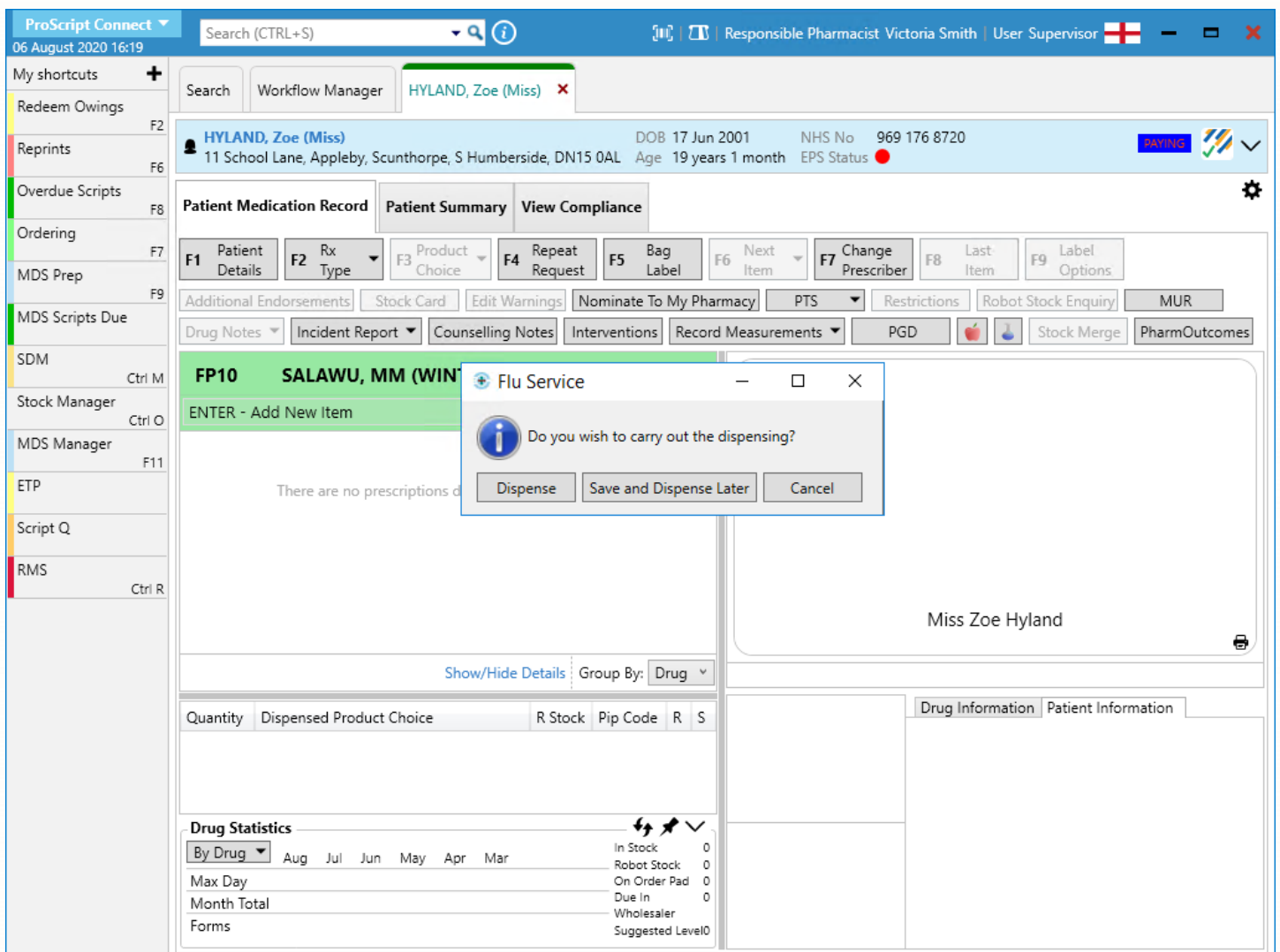


Completing a Saved NHS Flu Service PGD

Saving the Service to be Dispensed Later

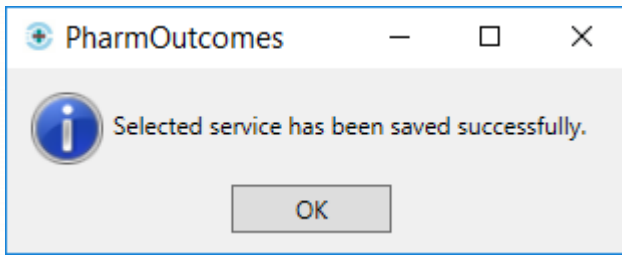
 You will need to be accredited to deliver the NHS Flu Service, by enrolling onto the service via the PharmOutcomes website.

1. After you have recorded the NHS Flu Service Provision in PharmOutcomes and returned to ProScript Connect, a Flu Service prompt displays on the patient's PMR. You can choose to either:
 - o Select the **[Dispense]** button if you wish to continue with dispensing the medication immediately;
 - o Select the **[Save and Dispense Later]** button if you wish to dispense the medication later on in the day;
 - o Select the **[Cancel]** button if you wish to cancel dispensing the medication.



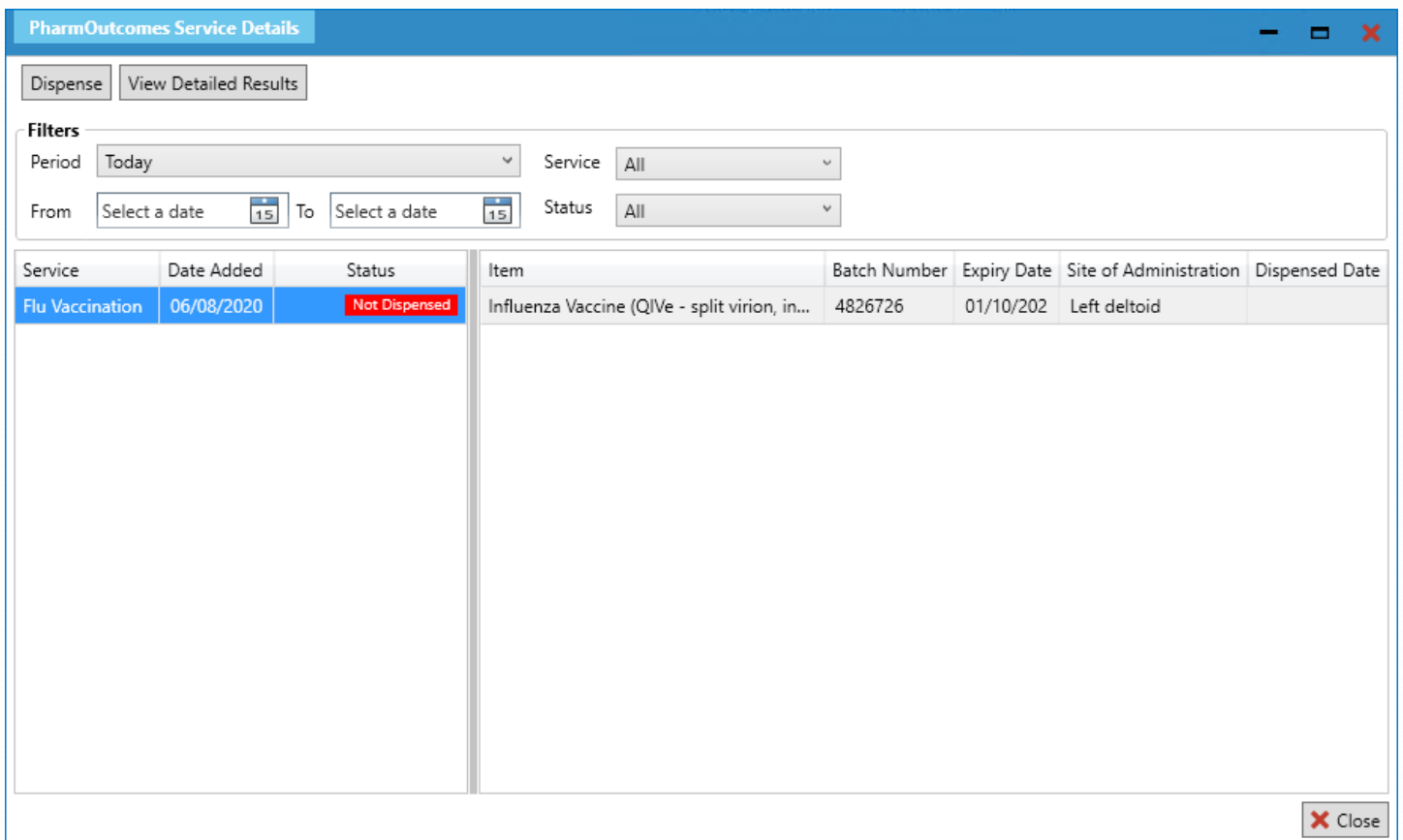

Dispense the Medication

1. Select the **[PharmOutcomes]** button within the patient's PMR. The PharmOutcomes Service Details window displays, with the filter *Period* set to *Today* by default. Highlight the *Flu Vaccination* service with a status of **Not Dispensed**. Notice that the *Item*, *Batch Number*, *Expiry Date* and *Site of Administration* have been automatically populated, based on the information entered when recording the service on PharmOutcomes.

2. Select the **[View Detailed Results]** button. The Flu Service Detailed Results window appears, where you can review all the responses that were provided when recording the service provision on PharmOutcomes. Select the **[Close]** button to close the window and return to the PharmOutcomes Service Details window.

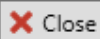

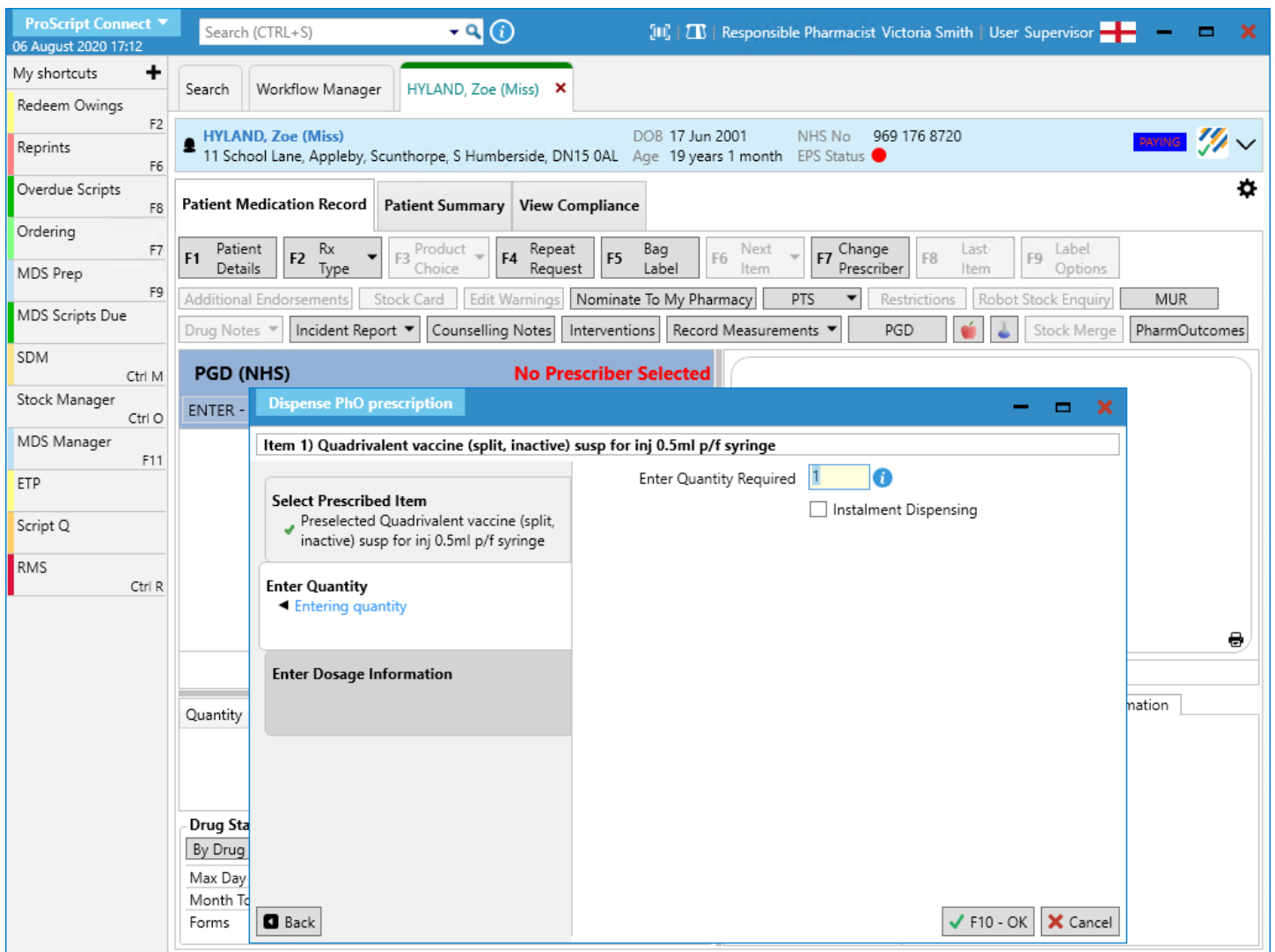

3. Make sure that the *Flu Vaccination* service with a status of **Not Dispensed** in the PharmOutcomes Service Details window is still highlighted. Select the **[Dispense]** button. The Dispense PhO prescription window displays, with the *Enter Quantity* tab opened by default. The *Rx Type* in the background has been automatically set to *PGD (NHS)*. Notice that the *Prescribed Item* has been automatically pre-selected, to match the item that was selected when recording the provision on PharmOutcomes. Review the quantity and select the **[F10 – OK]** button.
