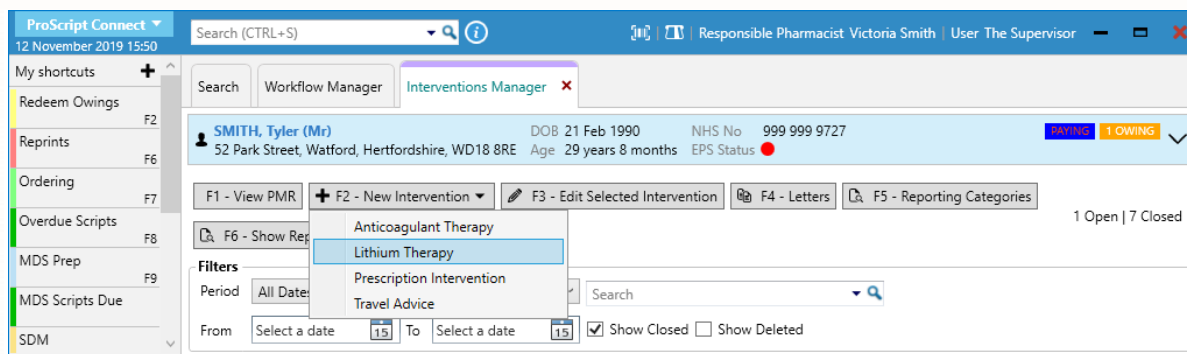


Adding a New Lithium Therapy Intervention

You can add a new lithium therapy intervention from the Interventions Manager or directly from the patient's PMR.

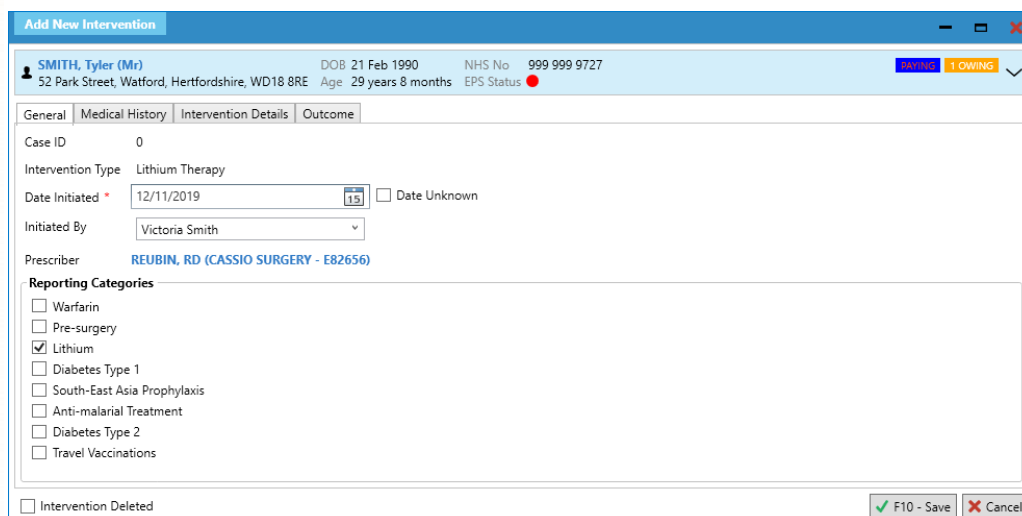
1. You can access the Interventions Manager from the top left-hand corner of the ProScript Connect Main Screen, by clicking **ProScript Connect** > **Interventions**.
2. From the Interventions Manager, click **[F2 – New Intervention]** and select the *Lithium Therapy* option.



3. The Select Patient to Add Intervention window displays.
4. Search for and select the patient for which you want to add a new intervention record.
5. The Add New Intervention window displays, with the *General* tab selected by default.
6. You can now complete the four tabs of the lithium therapy intervention.


Completing the General tab

The *General* tab enables you to enter the date the intervention was initiated, type/select who initiated the intervention, select the prescriber and select one or more reporting categories which apply to the intervention.



Completing the Medical History tab

The *Medical History* tab enables you to select the prescription type, medication related to the intervention, lithium monitoring details, and the reason for the lithium therapy.

Completing the Intervention Details tab

The *Intervention Details* tab enables you to select the clinical significance, reason(s) for the intervention and enter notes if applicable.

If you have selected *Drug Interaction (Risk Of)* as a reason for the intervention, you are able to add the drug(s) that are causing an interaction.

The *Outcome* tab enables you to select the action taken as a result of the issue raised during the intervention and its outcome, enter any adjoining note, select the intervention status and the date at which it was complete if applicable and the resolution time.
