Deleting an Intervention Letter

The Intervention Letters Manager enables you to add, edit, delete and print letter templates, which you can use to liaise with a third party, such as a nurse, GP or specialist, regarding a patient intervention.




Intervention letter templates are only available for anticoagulant therapy, lithium therapy and prescription interventions.

- 1. You can access the Interventions Manager from the top left-hand corner of the ProScript Connect Main Screen, by clicking ProScript Connect > Interventions.
- 2. From the Interventions Manager, highlight either an anticoagulant therapy, lithium therapy or prescription intervention in the grid and press [F4 Letters].
- 3. The Intervention Letters Manager window displays.



- 4. From the Intervention Letters Manager, highlight a letter in the grid and press [F2 Edit Letter].
- 5. The Intervention Letter window displays.






- 6. From the bottom left-hand corner, select the lacksquare Letter Deleted tick box.
- 7. Press [F10 Save].


Restoring a Deleted Intervention Letter

- You can access the Interventions Manager from the top left-hand corner of the ProScript Connect Main Screen, by clicking ProScript Connect > Interventions.
- 2. From the Interventions Manager, highlight either an anticoagulant therapy, lithium therapy or prescription intervention in the grid and press [F4 Letters].
- 3. The Intervention Letters Manager window displays.






- 4. Any deleted intervention letters display with a DELETED tag.
- Highlight the DELETED intervention letter and press [F2 Edit Letter].
- 6. The Intervention Letter window displays with a DELETED watermark.



7. From the bottom left-hand corner of the Intervention Letter window, deselect the Letter Deleted tick box.



- 8. Press [F10 Save].
- 9. You are returned to the Intervention Letters Manager, where the letter is no longer tagged as deleted.
