Deleting a Preparation or Pack Note

- To begin, open the Drug Notes Manager from the ProScript Connect Main Screen by clicking the [ProScript Connect] menu button and selecting the *Drug Notes Manager* menu item.
- From the Drug Notes Manager, select either the *Preparation* or *Pack Note* tab and use the available *Filters* to search for, locate and highlight the note you wish to delete. Select the [F2 Edit Note] button.

4. Select the **[F10 – Save]** button. You are returned to the Drug Notes Manager grid. Your note initially appears with a **DELETED** tag but will be removed from the main grid once refreshed.

Deleted pack and preparation notes can be located from the Drug Notes Manager grid by selecting the *Show Deleted* tick box if required.

Restoring a Deleted Preparation or Pack Note

- To begin, open the Drug Notes Manager from the ProScript Connect Main Screen by clicking the [ProScript Connect] menu button and selecting the *Drug Notes Manager* menu item.
- 2. From the Drug Notes Manager, select either the *Preparation* or *Pack Note* tab depending on the type of note you wish to restore.
- Select the Show Deleted tick box. All deleted notes will appear in the grid with a DELETED tag. Use the available *Filters* to search for, locate and highlight the note you wish to restore. Select the [F2 Edit Note] button.
