


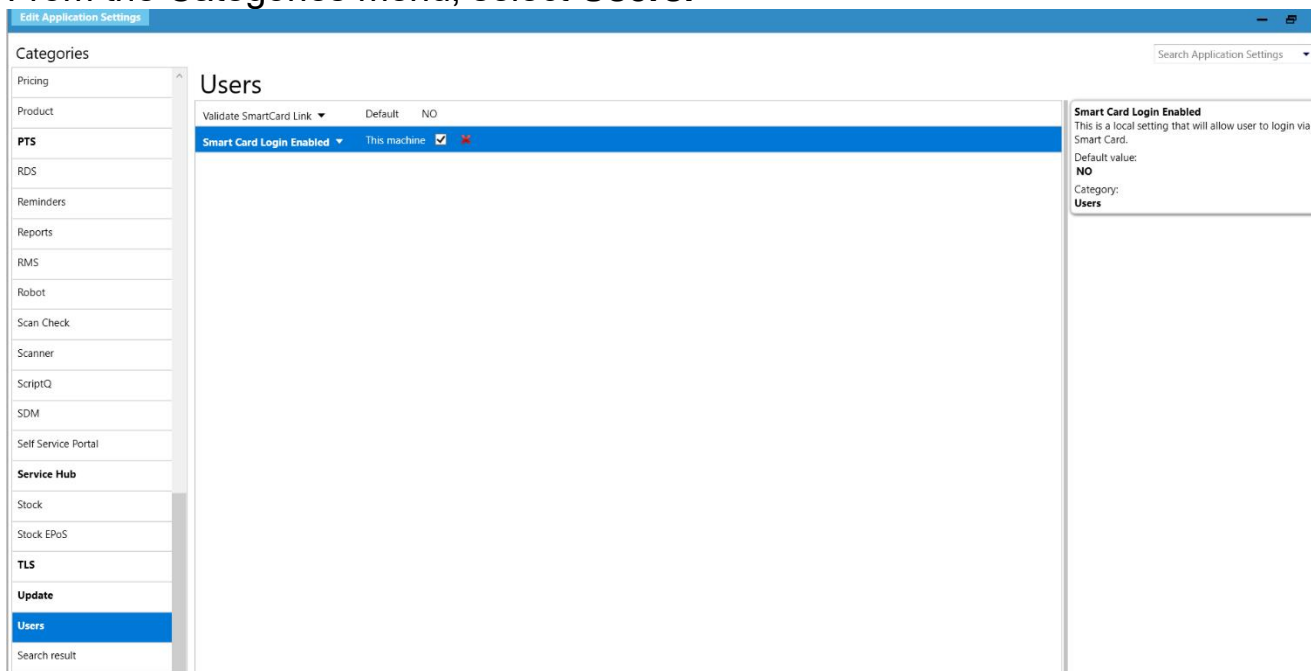
Configuring ProScript Connect to login with a smartcard

Users in England can have a smartcard linked to their user account, allowing them to launch ProScript Connect by clicking **F8 - Login via smartcard** on the login screen.

 The **F8 - Login via smartcard** option will be disabled if the currently inserted smartcard has not been linked to a user.

Configuration

1. From the ProScript Connect menu, select **Edit Application Settings**.
2. From the Categories menu, select **Users**.

Linking a smartcard

You can also link the currently inserted smartcard to the user.

1. Insert the user's smartcard into the smartcard reader.

2. The Identity Agent screen is displayed. Enter your passcode, then click **OK**.

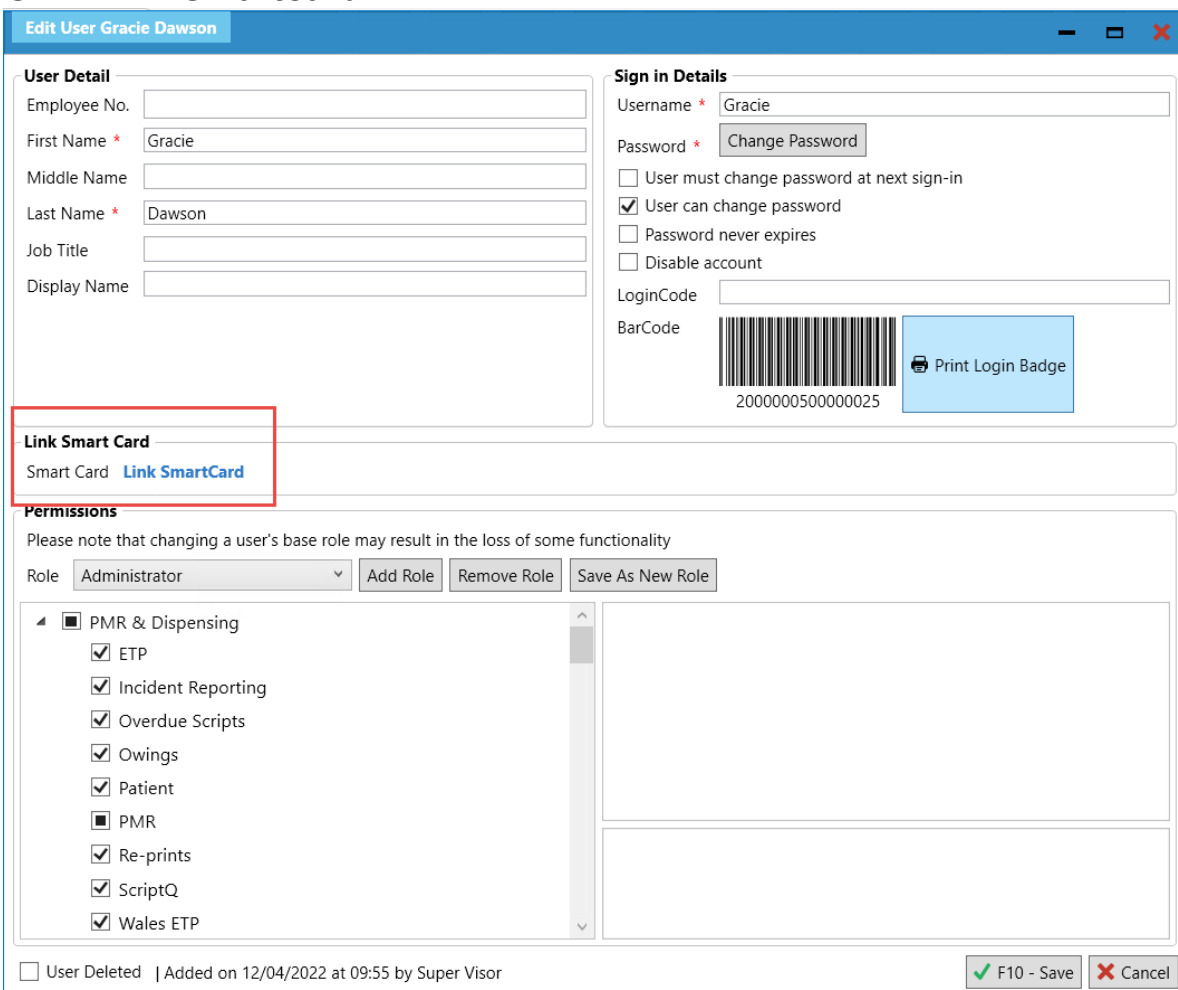

3. The Identity Agent displays the roles associated with your smartcard. Select the required role and click **OK**.

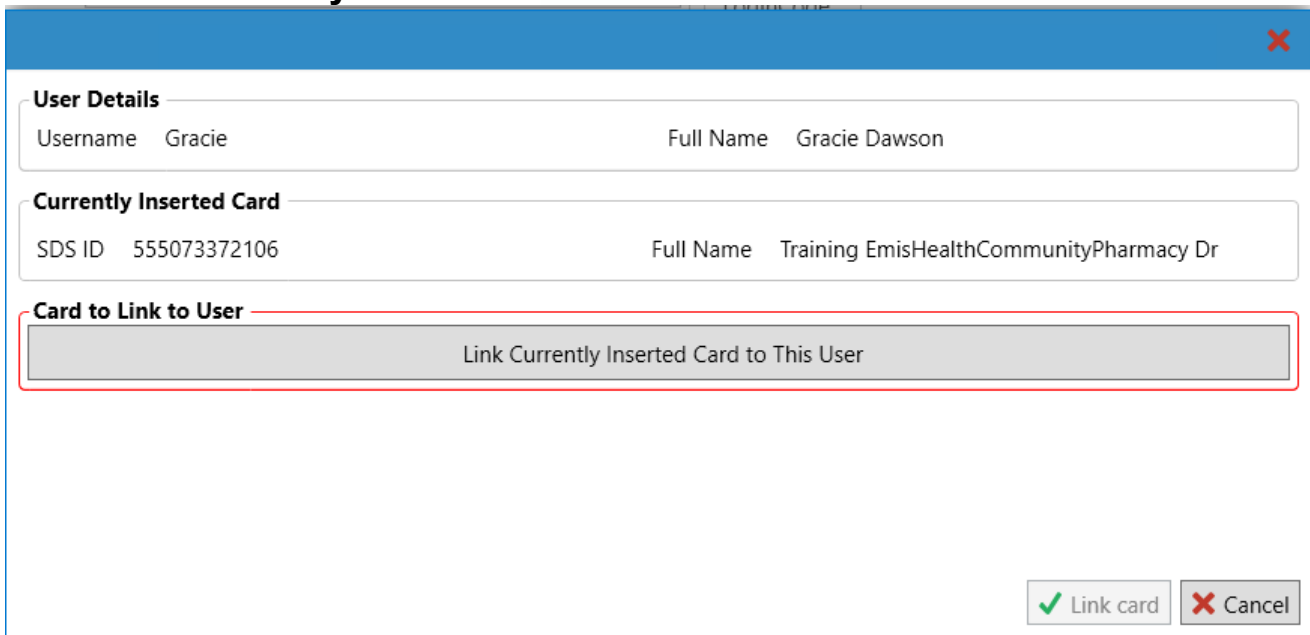
4. A confirmation message is displayed in the bottom right-hand corner. Click **X** to close.

6. Click **Link smartcard**.



7. Click **Link Currently Inserted Card to This User**.
